#### New report | Yemen and explosive weapons: A death sentence for civilians

The bombing of populated areas in Yemen has inflicted devastation with multi-year, reverberating effects, according to <u>a</u> <u>new Humanity & Inclusion report, "Death Sentence to Civilians: The Long-Term Impact of Explosive Weapons in</u> <u>Populated Areas in Yemen."</u> Humanity & Inclusion, as a co-founding member of International Network on Explosive Weapons, is working with States to develop a strong political declaration to end the use of explosive weapons with wide-area effects in populated areas and to ensure support to victims. The U.S. has sent a delegation to relevant meetings but opposes the political declaration. **Staff in Sanaa available for comment. The COVID-19 pandemic not only threatens the health and incomes of families, communities, and countries, it also increases the risk of violence against women and other vulnerable groups. Jhpiego's focus during COVID-19 is ensuring the continuation of essential health services, including those that seek to protect women and families and respond to survivors of <u>gender-based violence</u> (GBV). Jhpiego is supporting ministries of health in Mozambique, Nepal and Pakistan to develop recommendations and activities to mitigate GBV during the pandemic. And in the Philippines, Jhiepgo created hotlines for reporting emergencies and on-the-spot GBV counseling, and are working with local organizations to
