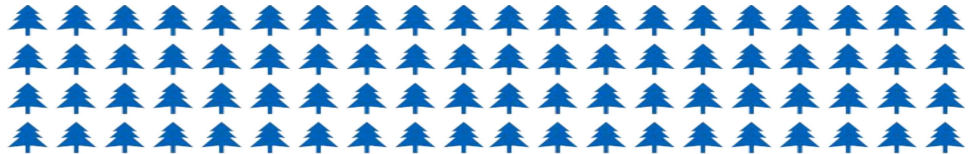

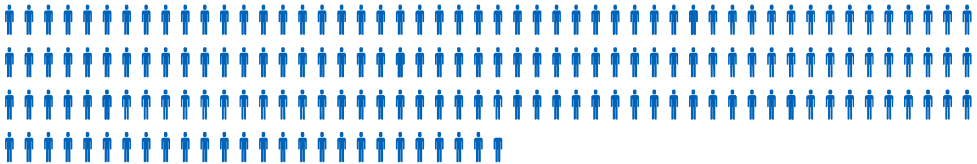

## Progress so far

- Our funding and programs are up – though still not where we need to be
- Early successes: over 60 million hectares conserved, \$340 million mobilized for climate adaptation
- We're becoming a climate agency – in humanitarian assistance, gender equity, our operations, and beyond
- Progress on PREPARE, Plan to Conserve Forests, Just Energy Transition Partnerships



## Strategy in Action: Early Warning for Food Security in Bangladesh

- Provided 250,000 farmers in disaster-prone areas with access to weather alerts
- Average savings of \$467 in would-be production losses—compared with average annual income of under \$3,000
- *Pictured: Feed the Future supported farmer in Bangladesh*



## Strategy in Action: President's Malaria Initiative

- Protecting populations from Malaria during severe weather events, like Tropical Cyclone Freddy in Mozambique
- **Halved** emissions from 2019 levels in part by switching to ocean freight
- *Pictured: USAID Supplies Mosquito Nets After Cyclone Freddy*

- Strengthen connections across USAID priorities, eg localization, equity, private sector engagement
